### **Hints from Pat Moore's class:**

To paint miniature hearts, put 2 dots of paint where the top of the heart is to be and drag downward between the dots to form the bottom of the heart.

To remove dry acrylic paint from brushes, soak in rubbing alcohol and rub to remove paint. To remove dry paint from clothes, saturate with the alcohol and then scrape to remove the paint. Do not try to wipe the paint when wet as it will bury it in the fabric.
