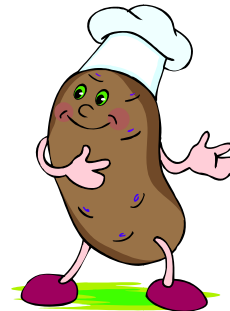
UPDATE ON THE CAPITOL CARVERS APRIL SHOW

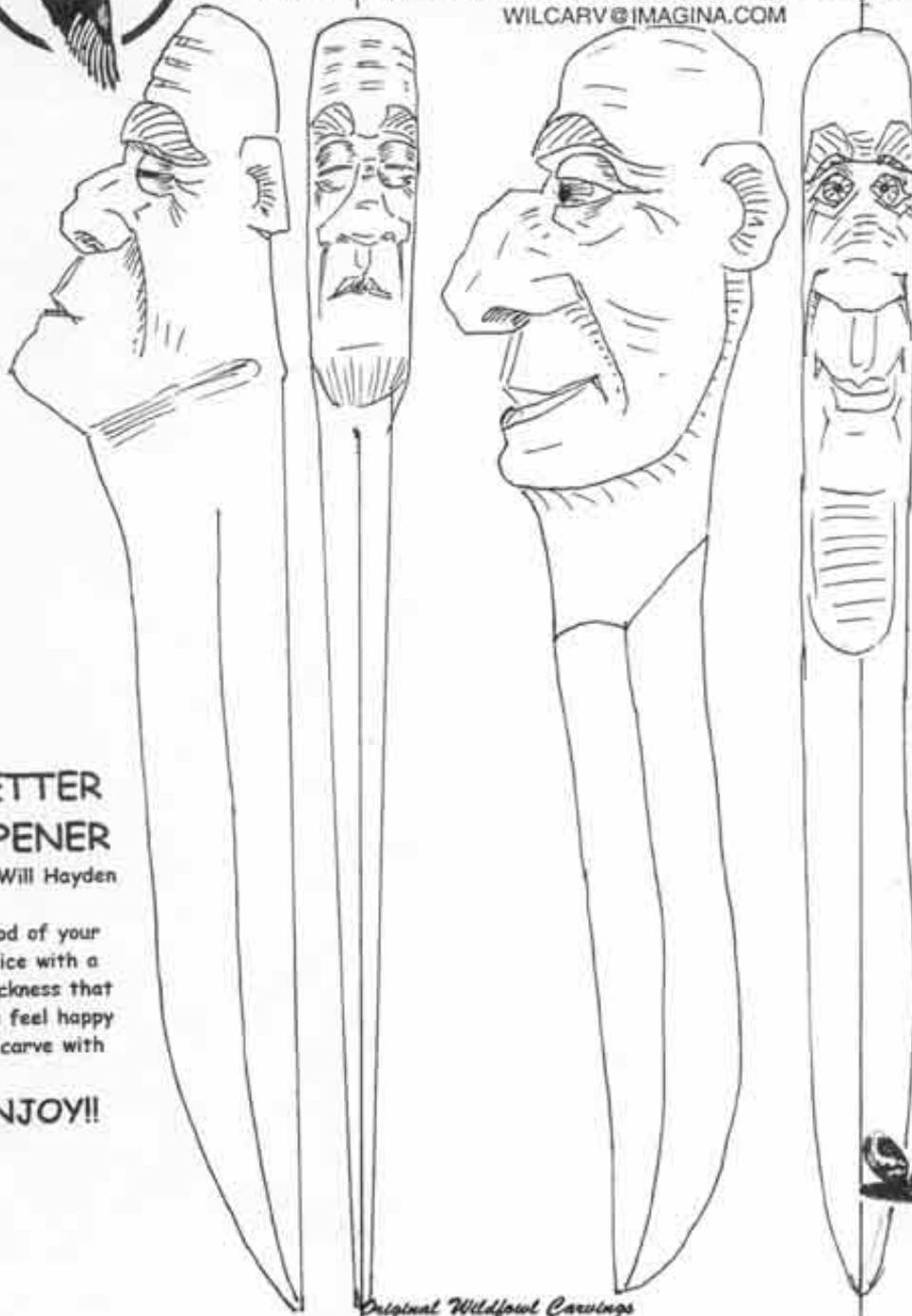

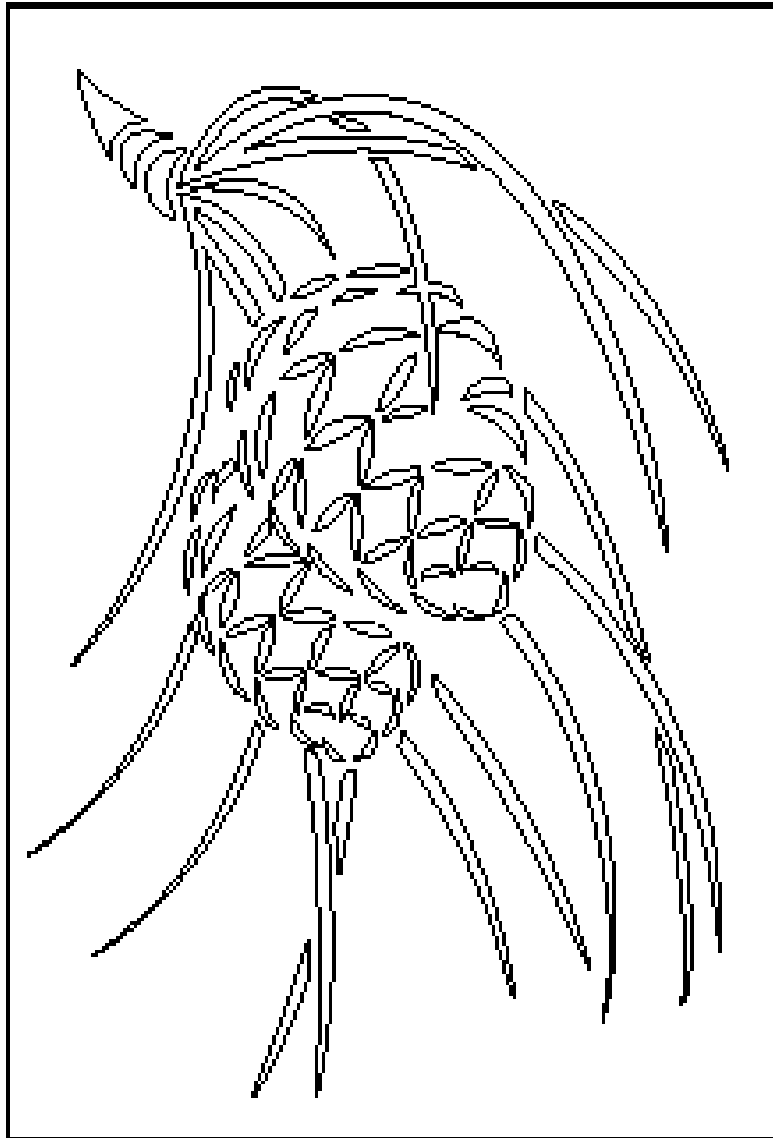
