Club Library



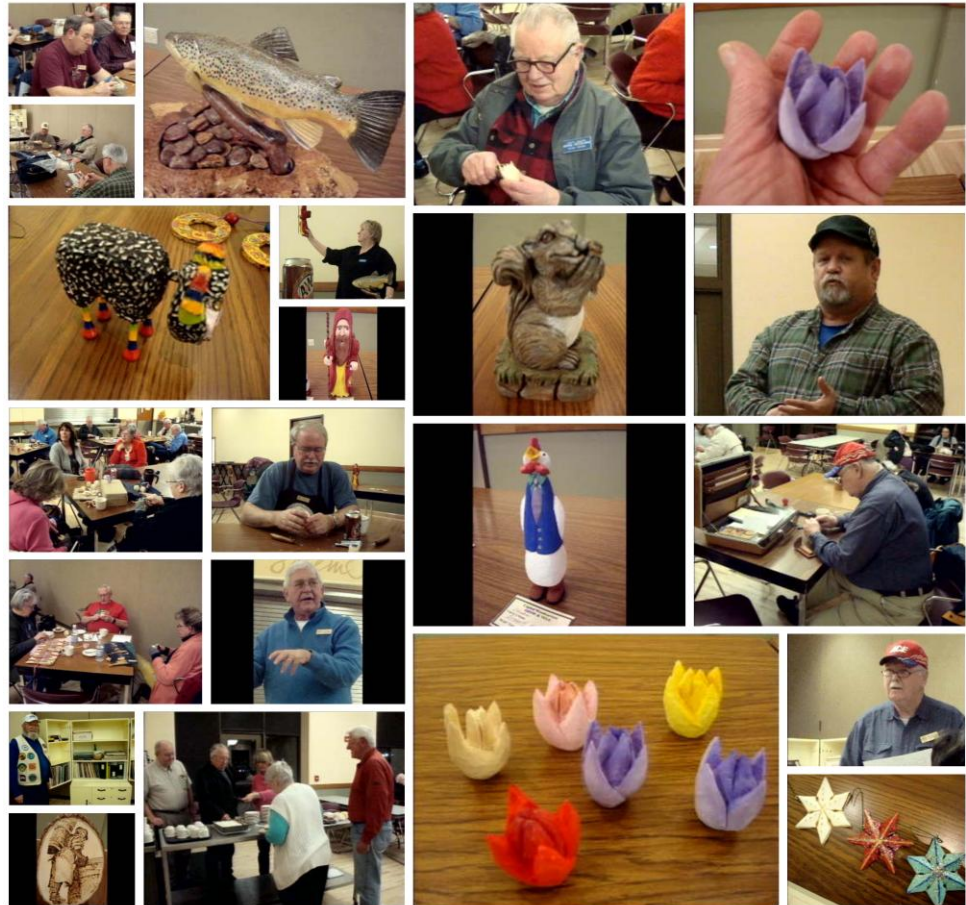
Barb Fromherz, Club Librarian, has done an outstanding job modernizing and organizing our library. She and Don have created an updated book catalog and
