Annual Show 2018 Carving Contest Rules

Updated: March 10, 2018.

All carvings, *without exception*, must be hand delivered and picked up at the exhibit hall. Carvings must be no more than two (2) years old and have not won a ribbon in a previous Capitol Woodcarvers Show. Only one (1) carving may be entered in each category.

First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded in each of the categories below:

<i>Youth</i>	Must be less than 18 years of age
<i>Beginner</i>	Must be a carver for less than three (3) years
<i>Intermediate</i>	Must be a carver for more than three (3) years and less than five (5) years
<i>Advanced</i>	Must be a carver for more than five (5) years
<i>Wood Burning</i>	
<i>Caricature / Whimsical / Fantasy</i>	
<i>Relief Carving</i>	
<i>Chip Carving</i>	
<i>Wildlife / Wildfowl</i>	

Single ribbons will be awarded in the categories below:

Best of Show Award.

These carvings must have been carved since last year's show. Carvers must be a registered exhibitor of the show and have won two (2) first place ribbons in any category or two (2) Best of Show / People's Choice ribbons in previous shows

These awards may vary from year to year:

Center 50+ Directors Award

Carousel Director's Award

Vendor's Award

Henry Memorial Award. This award is determined by representative(s) of the Henry family or designated by Show Committee. The award is to be chosen from the various show categories.

Disselbrett Award – best beginning carver. Selected by the Annual Show Committee
